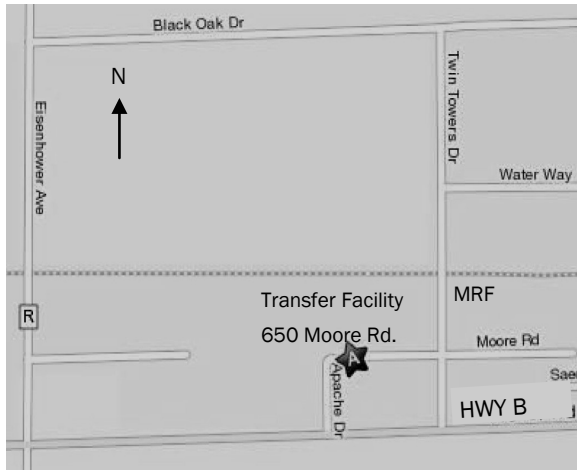




**Location:** The Solid Waste Transfer Facility (SWTF) is located about one mile east of I-39 on County Hwy B (Exit 153) in the Village of Plover Industrial Park. Turn north on Apache Drive. The Solid Waste Transfer Facility is on Moore Road west of the Material Recovery Facility (MRF).

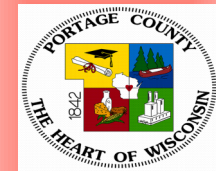

- ◆ Used Motor Oil
- ◆ Oil Filters
- ◆ Rechargeable Batteries (Ni-Cd, Ni-Mh, Li-Ion, Pb)
- ◆ Commingled Containers: Steel, Aluminum, Glass, Plastics # 1, #2
- ◆ Papers (Newspaper, Magazines, Phonebooks, Mixed Paper, Corrugated Cardboard)
- ◆ Fluorescents
- ◆ Computers / Electronics
- ◆ Televisions
- ◆ Agricultural and Household Hazardous Materials
- ◆ Confidential Papers for free shredding

## Delivering to the Transfer Facility

Open to the public, the SWTF accepts many types of waste and recyclables.

**All loads must be covered or enclosed!**

Uncovered loads will be refused and cited.

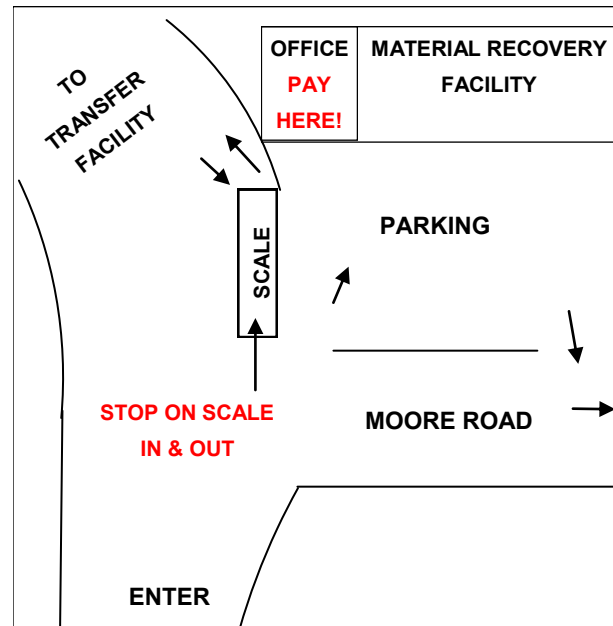
**All loads are weighed** upon arrival.

**Stop at scale and register.**

Ask attendant where to unload.

**Stop and weigh at scale after unloading.**

**Stop at the office** to pay or you will be cited.



## Be Safe!

**ONLY** authorized personnel allowed in processing warehouse or active areas.

- No person under 16 allowed outside of vehicle.
- No pets allowed.
